2012 Winter Sporting Clays Sub-gauge League



What a sub gauge league? Of course why not? How does this work?

Along with the normal Sporting Clays league Ilion always runs each winter, we are starting a handicapped league based on the sub-gauge guns and type. Here are the break downs for the number of birds given where the 20ga O/U is the zero handicap. Oh; there is a maximum of 45 with handicap, want higher than that then you have to break them on your own. In other words no score plus handicap will exceed 45. To get a 48 you must break 48 targets regardless of gauge or type.

Handicap Maximum = 45		
Gauge	Type	Handicap (# of Birds)
20 Gauge	O/U	Zero
20 Gauge	Pump	+3 Birds
20 Gauge	SxS	+3 Birds
28 Gauge	O/U	+5 Birds
28 Gauge	Pump	+8 Birds
28 Gauge	SxS	+8 Birds
.410 Gauge	O/U	+10 Birds
.410 Gauge	Pump	+13 Birds
.410 Gauge	SxS	+13 Birds

Cost: Nothing extra, just a normal round of clays. This is for bragging rights

Misc: One week a 20 gauge, the next .410 pump, it's all up to you.

How many rounds: Only **8 rounds** are needed to complete the league, ties broken by true score average. **Can be shot after the normal league*

What can you win? High overall wins a beautiful **plastic trophy**.
